Management Report

2020 Plan:

- ➤ Activity Cards 852 more sold this year compared to last year. This is a 17.2% increase. (As of 4/30)
- ➤ Boat Registrations 114 more registered this year compared to last year. This is a 3.2%increase. (As of 4/30)

2020 Impact of COVID-19:

- Still too early and too unpredictable to determine the full financial impact of COVID-19.
- Through the end of April, revenue has been negatively impacted. Management has made significant cuts to expenses. At this point the POA is performing better than budget as a result of these cuts.

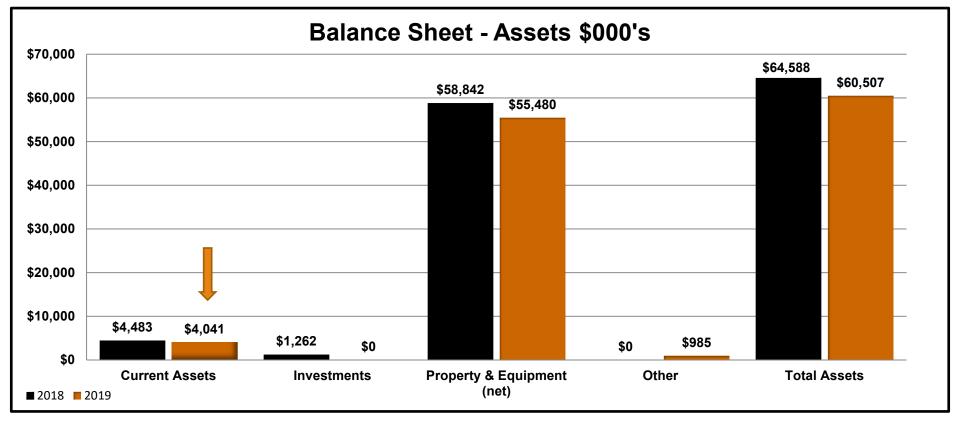

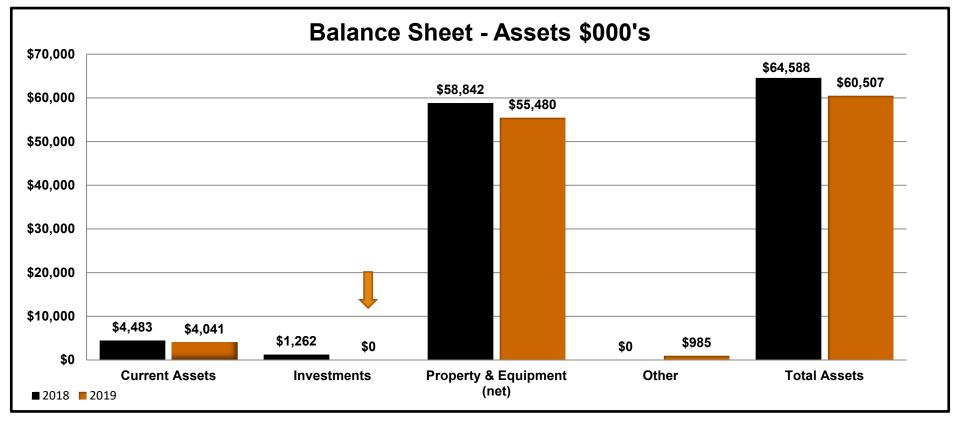

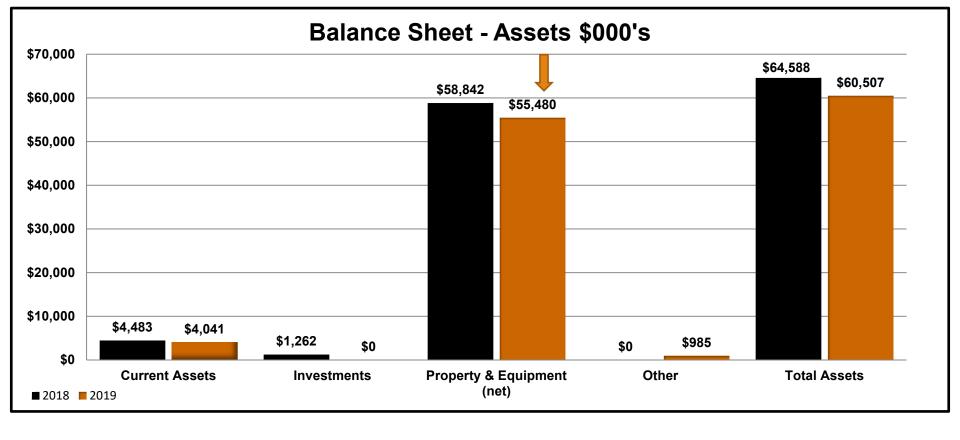
Balance Sheet Assets

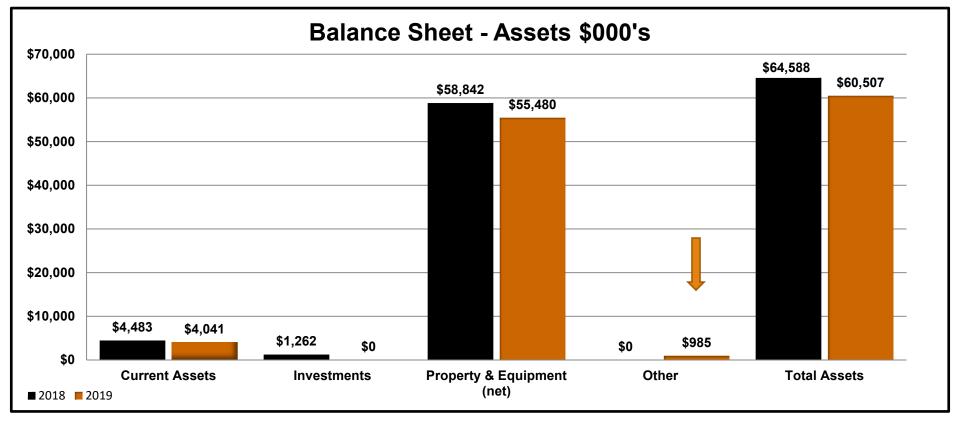
Investments decreased (\$1.3 million)
Use of Cash on Trafalgar Fire



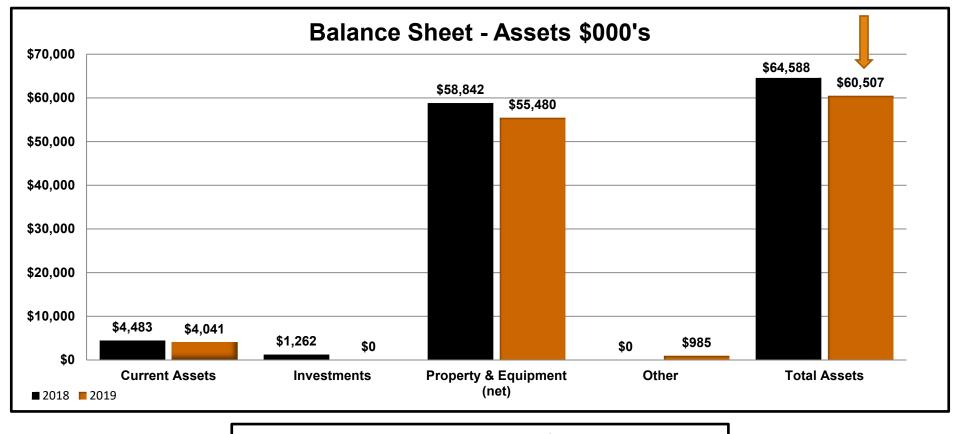
Property Plant & Equipment net of accumulated depreciation decreased (\$3.4 million)

Sale of AR MO Land



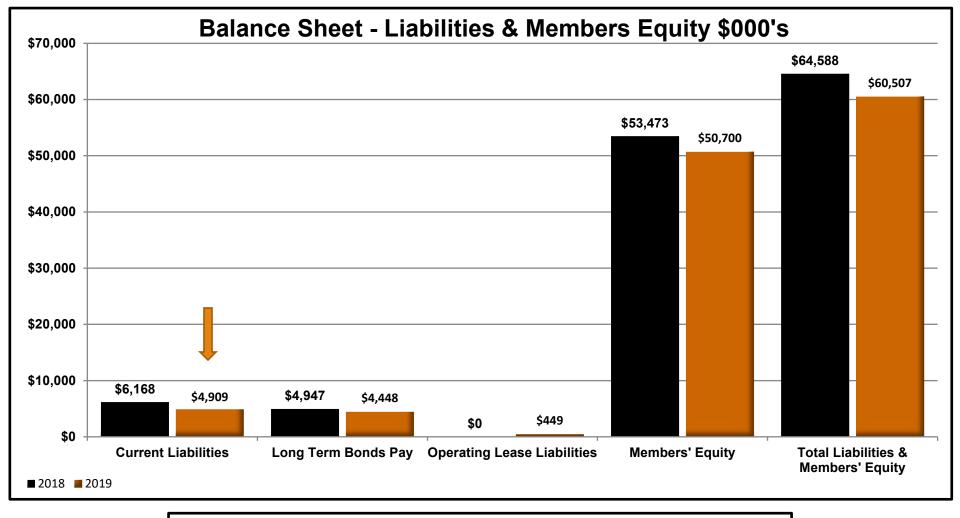
Other Assets increased \$990k Right - of - Uses Assets - Operating Leases



Total Assets decreased (\$4.1 million)

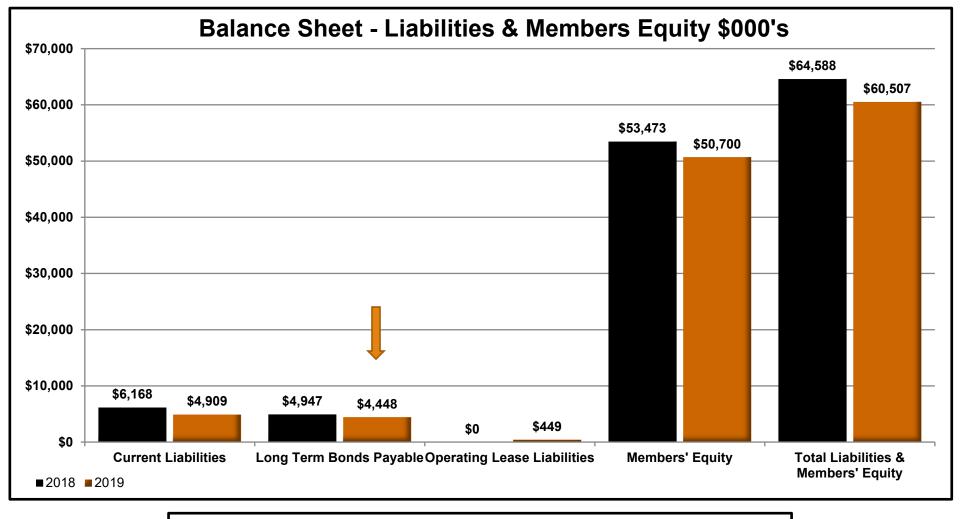

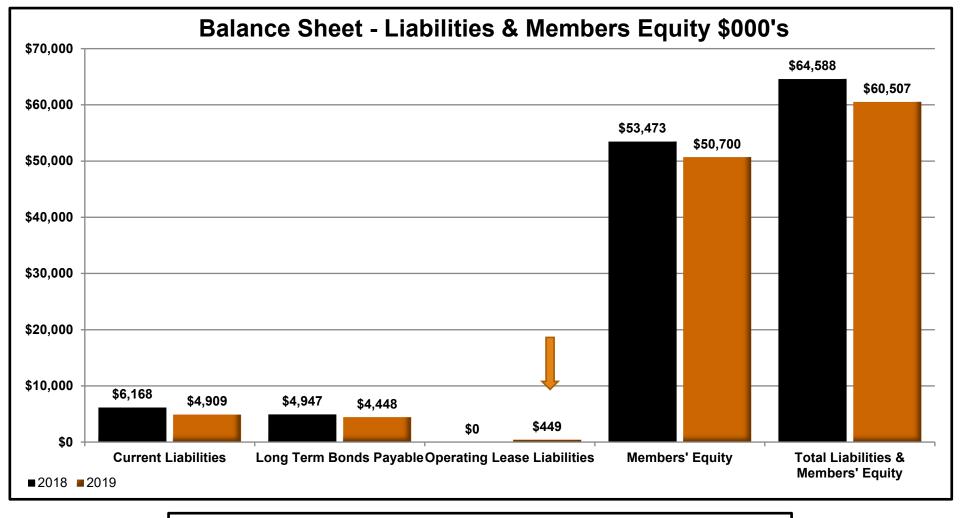


Current Liabilities- decreased (\$1.3 million)

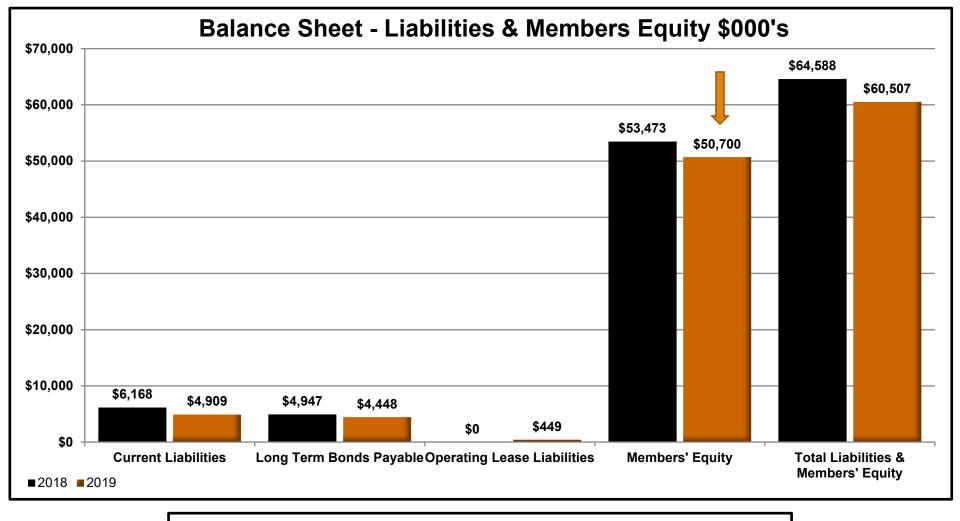
- Trafalgar Fire Liability decrease(\$1.7 million)

- Members' Prepaid Fees & Assessments decrease (\$280k)



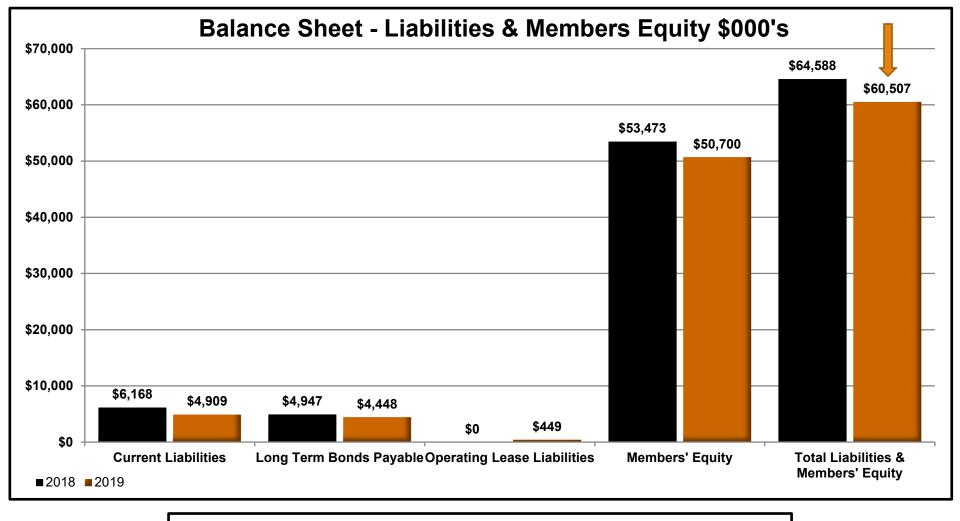

Operating Lease Liabilities- increased \$449k Long Term Lease Liability



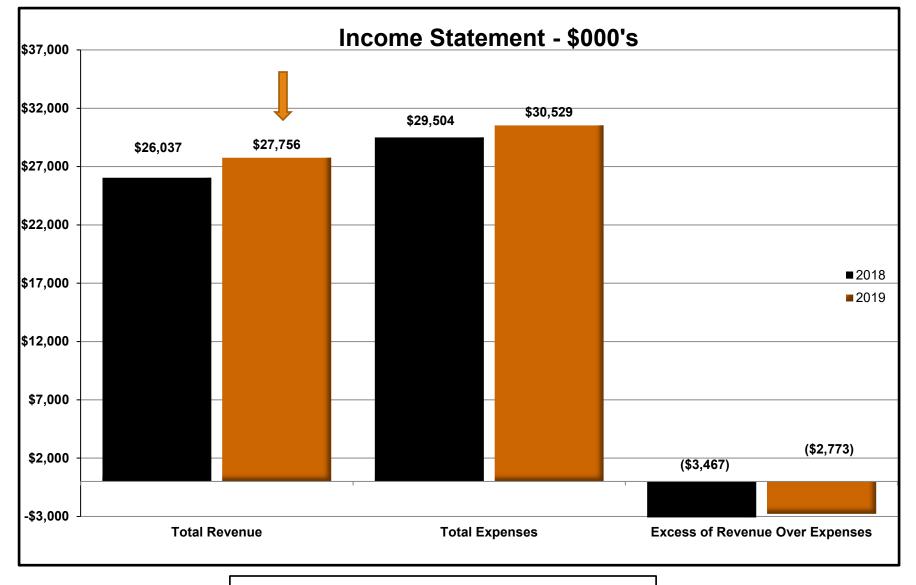
Members' Equity – decreased (\$2.8 million) Net loss

- Members' Equity decreased (\$2.8 million)

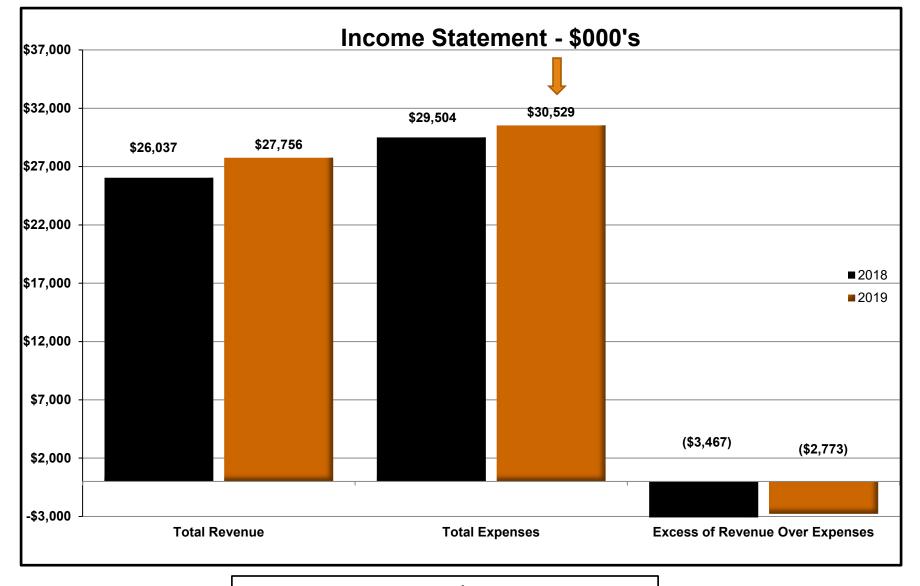
Income Statement

Revenue Year Over Year

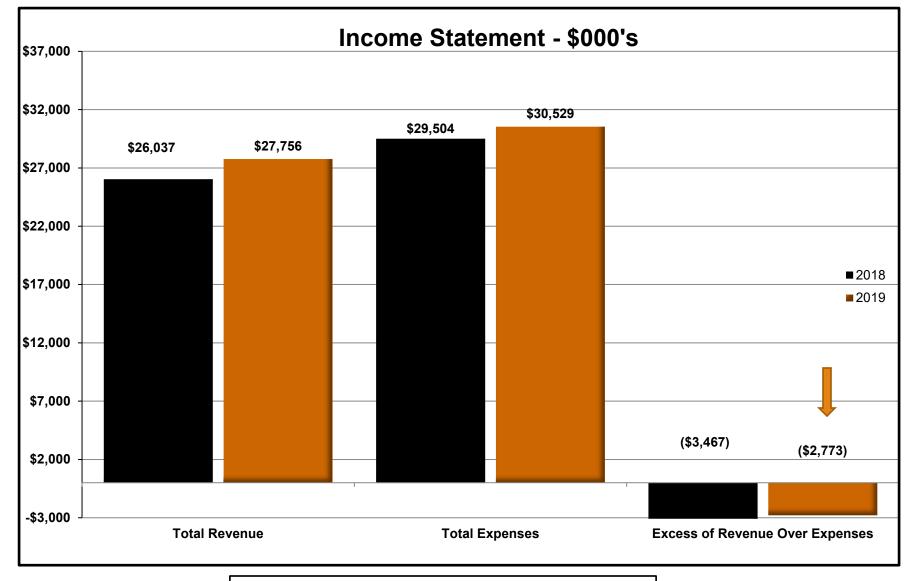
- Cell Tower Income \$1.37 million Cell tower equipment sale between outside parties
- Food & Beverage \$400k BV's 84% Lakepoint 8%, Highlands 4%, Golf Pro Shops 4%
- Gain on Sale of Assets \$350k Sale of AR Mo Land
- **Member Assessments \$195k** Assessments, Transfer Fees and Collection Efforts
- **Golf Fees (\$155k)** *Greens fees and cart rentals*
- Water (\$217k) Decreased water usage



2019 Expenses \$30.5 million Compared with \$29.5 million in 2018

Expenses Year Over Year

- Small Equipment & Tools \$363k Purchases across the divisions
- Salaries & Wages \$306k Savings across divisions
- **Employee Benefits \$187k** *Self Funded Health Insurance & Payroll Taxes*
- Repair & Maintenance \$140k Savings across divisions
- **Service Contracts (\$120k)** Water Meter replacement Program Monthly Wi-Fi
- Assessment Elections (\$80k) Two Assessment Votes
- **Depreciation (\$395k)** *Increased depreciation expense from prior year projects*
- Environmental Expense (\$1.33 million) Trafalgar Fire
