### **GENERAL COURSE UPDATE:**

- Greens aeration scheduled in April
  - BVCC 18<sup>th</sup> and 19<sup>th</sup>

  - Kingswood April 20<sup>th</sup> and 21<sup>st</sup>
  - Dogwood April 21<sup>st</sup> and 22<sup>nd</sup>

- Highlands Drill and Fill and normal core aeration completed in March
- New Tee Signage installed at Dogwood
- Completed all addition Gold tee block installation in fairways
- Painting of Gold tee Logo's on fairways scheduled for this month

#### **BVCC Collar Project**

## CAPITAL EQUIPMENT UPDATES:

- All equipment delivered and in use
  - Greens Roller @ Scotsdale
  - Pull behind Blower @ Dogwood
  - 4X4 Truck @ Metfield
- **Golf Operations – Darryl:**
  - **Golf rounds.**
    - March rounds ended at 10,380.
      - Down by 1,683 over last year.
      - Members rounds down by 1,652.
      - Guest rounds down by 31.
    - Year to date rounds ended at 18,028.
      - Down by 2,591 over last year.
      - Members rounds ended at 14,517.
        - Down by 2,617 over last year.
      - Guest rounds ended at 3,511.
        - Up by 26 over last year.
    - Range buckets year to date 9,044 (down by 375).
      - March buckets down by 897 over last year.
    - Darryl said rounds and buckets were down to Cold and Wet March.
    - When golf course is open, it's very busy. Need warm weather.
  - **Walking on Golf Courses. Not allowed on golf courses when open. It is for safety reasons to prevent accidents. If you see people walking on golf courses when open, please contact the Pro Shop.**
  - **New Carts**-Next 10 days golf carts will be delivered to BVCC and Dogwood. Kingswood will receive golf carts around May 1<sup>st</sup>.
    - Sand bottles are being used quite a bit.
  - **Handicap Flags Cards**
    - Issuing new Handicap Flag Cards starting April 11<sup>th</sup>. Old cards will not be accepted on or after May 1<sup>st</sup>.

# HANDICAP FLAGS CARDS will expire April 30th, 2022.



Golf Operations will be issuing new Handicap Flag Cards starting April 11th. Those that meet (1) of the following requirements will need to come to Golf Operations before April 30th for a new card.

- Must be over the age of 80 (drivers license).
- Handicap Placard temporary or permanent for car.

Those holding a Handicap Flag card will be require to follow the below rules.

- **MUST GIVE HANDICAP FLAG CARD** to proshop or cart barn when checking out handicap flag. After completion of the round, please return flag and pickup card.
  - The flag is required to always be visible on the golf cart and may not be transferred from cart to cart.
  - **Carts need to stay 30 Feet away from all greens and tee boxes at all times.**
  - Stay on path on all Par 3's unless Handicap permissible is posted on hole sign.
  - Handicap flags will not be allowed on days that are **CART PATH ONLY.**

- Board approved an assessment vote on Aug. 10<sup>th</sup> for a \$3.00 monthly increase for improved properties only.
  - Smaller increases more frequently.
  - If assessment vote approved, no amenities fee usage increases for three years.
  - If assessment is not approved, we will have to look at increases to amenities fee usage.
  - Reasonable amount to provide great benefits to the membership.

- Susan said there is a Divot repair day at Dogwood on April 26 at 9:00 am with a combine effort with maintenance and Friends of Dogwood. Need more volunteers. Makes a big difference for the course.
